FROM THE LARRY FRUSHER FAMILY:

(Thursday) Larry is in Via Christi St. Francis in Wichita. Only prayers got us through this. He was fed jello this morning and saw the surgeon who operated on him. Dr. Howes said when he got him opened up Larry was the same as a dead man. Anyone else, and this would have killed him. Larry had 3 pints of blood in his stomach. That blood they were able to suck out and transfuse him with his own blood. They removed about 5 inches of his bowel that was a tangled mess. He is weak but has walked some. Larry said yesterday that he never thought he would live through this.

For those who do not know, Larry was hit in the stomach by a wooden post they were pulling out of the ground at 9 AM Monday. It was chained to a payday loader and got caught somehow and flew right up into Larry's stomach. He had internal bleeding but no outer lacerations. None of us realized this. He came in and was on the couch thinking he would be okay. About noon he got up and started passing out. He passed out 4 times before Ben and Russell got him in the car. They did an MRI of his internal organs at Jetmore and found everything okay but the bowel area. By the time we knew he was bleeding internally and it was extremely serious, we waited on a plane crew that arrived at 5PM. He was met at the ER doors in Wichita immediately by a trauma team and taken to surgery. He has had wonderful care. Thank you to all who knew and prayed. I cannot possible answer all the emails that I have received. Feel free to share with others who may be interested.
